



## Roger Bryan Elementary School Parent and Family Engagement Policy 2025-2026

1. A. This policy has been jointly developed and agreed upon by the Roger Bryan Elementary School staff and parents of students served in the school pursuant to Title I. Roger Bryan Elementary School will convene an annual meeting, at a convenient time for parents to evaluate this policy. The meeting will be held on Monday, May 19, 2025 at 3:30pm via Zoom. The meet link for this meeting will be shared with parents through email via ParentLink and Class Dojo. This time has been chosen as the most convenient time for parents as this is after dismissal and right before our monthly School Organizational Team meeting. For parents unable to attend, the handouts and power point will be available on the school's website and an additional meeting will be held on Thursday, August 21, 2025. The school's parent involvement policy developed by administration, staff and parents will be distributed in an understandable and uniform format and to the extent practicable. The parent involvement policy is sent home through email (ParentLink) and posted on the school website.

1. B. During this meeting, administration will share the results of the annual District Wide Parent Survey. In addition, the student and staff results will be shared. The District Parent Survey results showed that some parents expressed concern with not having enough information with what is going on inside of the school. This year, to increase school to home communication, all teachers are using Class Dojo to provide parents with information. In addition, regular updates occur through the school website, school Facebook page, and notes and flyers through ParentLink. Parents are encouraged to participate in the District Survey.

2. Plan for including parents in the writing of the school Improvement Plan: Roger Bryan Elementary School will involve parents in an organized, ongoing and timely way in the planning, review and improvement of Title I programs, School Performance Plan and Parent and Family Engagement Policy.

3. Information regarding the Educational Involvement Accords: The Educational Involvement Accords are integrated into the registration process through Infinite Campus. Parents must review Accord prior to completing their child's registration. Administrators and teachers will have access to the Accords whenever needed for parent/student conferences or other occasions.

4. A. Administration and staff will:

1. Provide assistance to the parents in the understanding of the Nevada Academic Content Standards through parent meetings, Open House, and individual meetings with parents. Specific grade level standards information is on the school website. Parents receive a monthly progress report of their child's grades from the classroom teacher, in addition to grades being available daily through Infinite Campus. Roger Bryan staff also shares data regarding District assessments and progress monitoring.
2. Provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment enabling students to meet the state academic standards. Administration will provide support and training for teachers in standards and student expectations. All teachers implement the Nevada Academic Content Standards and utilize Curriculum Engine as a reference for the standards. Teachers meet during common planning times to analyze data and determine areas of strengths and weakness to guide instruction. The teachers create a warm, conducive learning environment that provides structure, rigor and motivates the students for success. Teachers use data from MAP, FastBridge, and schoolwide assessments to adjust their instruction. Roger Bryan has one paid Certified Temporary Tutor (CTT) who supports the growth of our English Language Learners and two

strategists (one Read by Grade Three and one Math Strategist) who support the growth of all teachers and students.

4. B. Roger Bryan will host either virtual or in person Family Engagement/Academic Nights this year dependent upon health guidelines by the District and the State. We will hold our Open House on August 7, 2025. Teachers provide educational materials to families, including a weekly instructional guide during distance learning, in order to support parents in supporting their children.

4. C. Incorporating parental feedback, administration will provide professional development to all members of the Roger Bryan Elementary staff regarding:

- \* Effective communication strategies between home and school (Class Dojo)
- \* Infinite Campus
- \* Effective parent-teacher conferences

4. D. All information related to school and parent programs, meetings and other activities is sent to parents in a variety of methods: notifications are sent through ParentLink, Infinite Campus, telephone messages, school website, school Facebook page, and through Class Dojo. Class Dojo allows for translation of messages into home languages for parents and translators are available upon request. Parents are provided with “Partners for Achievement,” information pertaining to the semester expectations regarding standards. This is also on our website.

4. E. To the extent feasible and appropriate, the administration and counselor will coordinate and integrate parent involvement programs and activities that encourage and support parents in more fully participating in the education of their children. Our school counselor partners with community members and organizations, such as Nevada PEP and CCSD’s Family Engagement Department, to share information with parents about training and services for them and their families in our area of town. Our strategists will hold meetings for parents to communicate information regarding specific content areas. Additionally, our preschool staff host parent engagement and involvement days throughout the year in which resources and activities are provided to parents.

4. F. Roger Bryan ES will provide reasonable support for parental involvement activities as parents may request including availability for conferences with teachers and administration, personal invites through the use of ParentLink and Class DoJo. Parents are encouraged to meet with administration regarding any concerns, suggestions, and accolades at all times. Written suggestion forms are in the front office during in-person learning sessions and parents are welcome to call with questions or concerns.

Parent’s involvement in the academic achievement of students include: assisting their child with homework, checking his/her grades on Infinite Campus and Canvas, encouraging the use of the various academic websites, and ensuring consistent student attendance.
